1. General provisions:

The rules and regulations (WB and RO) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV) and the anti-doping regulations will be in full force during the competitions. For handicapped swimmers with the appropriate classification of evidence the rules and regulations of the German Disabled Sports Federation (DBS) will be in force additionally.

The competition is accessible for national associations, clubs belonging to the DSV, which are in possession of the articles of association, as well as foreign clubs which association is part of the Fina.

The swimming pool is 50 m long with 10 lanes, divided by wave breaking ropes. The depth of the pool is 3.00 metres at all points. Water's temperature is 26°C. Automatic measuring will be in use. The one-start-rule will apply – no false start.

The Berliner Schwimm-Verband (BSV) will supply the judges.

2. Enrolment

Entries have to be made by using the official forms provided by the DSV (Entry form DSV-Form 101 and Entry list DSV-Form 102) and have to be send to:

If possible, entries have to be handed in via email using the DSV-6 standard form. It is recommended to add a copy printout. Incomplete or illegible entries cannot be taken into consideration.

Entries must be submitted until Tuesday 28.06.2016.

Entries, sent in before the official entry deadline, can be rejected if the number of entries exceeds the time limit provided for the competition. In this case the incoming date of the entry will be decisive.

All clubs ensure that all entered swimmers have a full proof of health capabilities for evidence, according to § 8 WB. The attest must not be older than one year. Entries without this reassurance will be rejected. Additionally, all clubs/ teams ensure that all entered swimmers have right to start for the club and paid the mandatory annual license according to § 12 Abs. 2 letter (f).

The clubs will receive a confirmation of receipt once the deadline is exceeded and all entries are entered in the competition-EDV. This will happen via email within 48 hours if an email address was provided. At the beginning of competition, all clubs will get a full printout of the entry list at the call room.

3. Entry fee:

The entry fee is 8,00 EURO per start and has to be transferred to the bank account of the Berliner TSC until 02.07.2016 at latest.

4. Set of heats

Heats will be set independently of the age group by using the entry times. For finals, the 8 fastest swimmer qualify in the open age group. There will be also finals of the EYOF-age group. If any swimmer from this age group qualifies in the open age group, he/she will be swimming in the open final. The placing of the EYOF-age groups will follow on times from all finals (open finals too).

The organizer reserves to oneself to use double occupancy of a lane in event 1, 2, 23 and 24, if the number of participants will exceed the time limit.

5. Prizes/ Awards

Awards will be given in two age groups:

1. EYOF-age group: 2001/2002 (women) and 2000/2001 (men)
2. Open age group: all age groups 2004 and older

Places 1-3 of each age group (male/ female) will receive medals and certificates.



6. Entry list/ Results

The complete entry lists and the results will be available on the meeting homepage www.berlinertsc-germanopen.de. Printouts of the results will not be provided to the teams. If it is able of the technical, there will be a livetiming.

7. Other

The organizers and Bäderbetriebe of Berlin are not liable for lost property, damages or injuries.

The competition was reported to the Berliner Schwimm-Verband (BSV) and the Deutscher Schwimm-Verband (DSV).
